



HCA Student Remediation Plan

As all of you are aware, HCA is an academically rigorous school relative to much of the “education” that takes place in our community. Having a rigorous academic program is likely one of the attributes that caused you to consider Haven as an option for your child. However, with rigor comes challenge. This is implicit in the motto “Maximizing your child’s God-given potential.” This is as it should be. How can we strive for excellence without expecting exertion or challenge? What team or individual achieves excellence without being adequately challenged and earning the “sweat equity” for excellence? In a recent Sports Illustrated article, Urban Meyer (Florida’s head football coach) asked his assistant coaches to make this preseason “the most challenging and demanding that any Florida team had ever experienced.” Coach Meyer’s order was on the heels of a National Championship in 2008 and the second championship in 3 years. As your child faces potential academic challenges this year, we have the following tutoring plan in place for their support. First, all HCA teachers are required to be available to students from immediately after carline until 3:30. Additionally, any student requiring English grammar tutoring may get assistance from Karen Wiggins on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 7:25-7:55AM. Should your grade 6-12 student require additional assistance in the maths or sciences, Jeremy Pletcher is available on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:15 – 4:00PM. For English, history, and Bible tutoring, Karen Wiggins is available on Mondays and Wednesdays from 3:15-4:00PM. I am requesting that these latter (afternoon) tutoring sessions be funded by parent donations as these teachers will be serving beyond their contractual obligations. For elementary grades K5-5, Mrs. James is available for tutoring from 7:00AM-8:00AM on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Mrs. Deckard is available on Mondays and Wednesdays from 3:15-4:15PM. If you desire to utilize these tutoring services for your child, please sign up in the office and submit your donation at least one day prior to the day you desire the services to commence. I am requesting that you make donations on a weekly basis for the duration of the services. A summary of the schedule is provided below:
